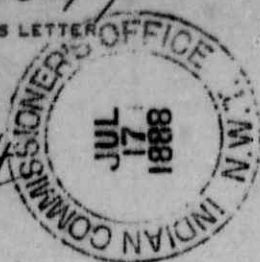

Ottawa, 13<sup>th</sup> July 1888
