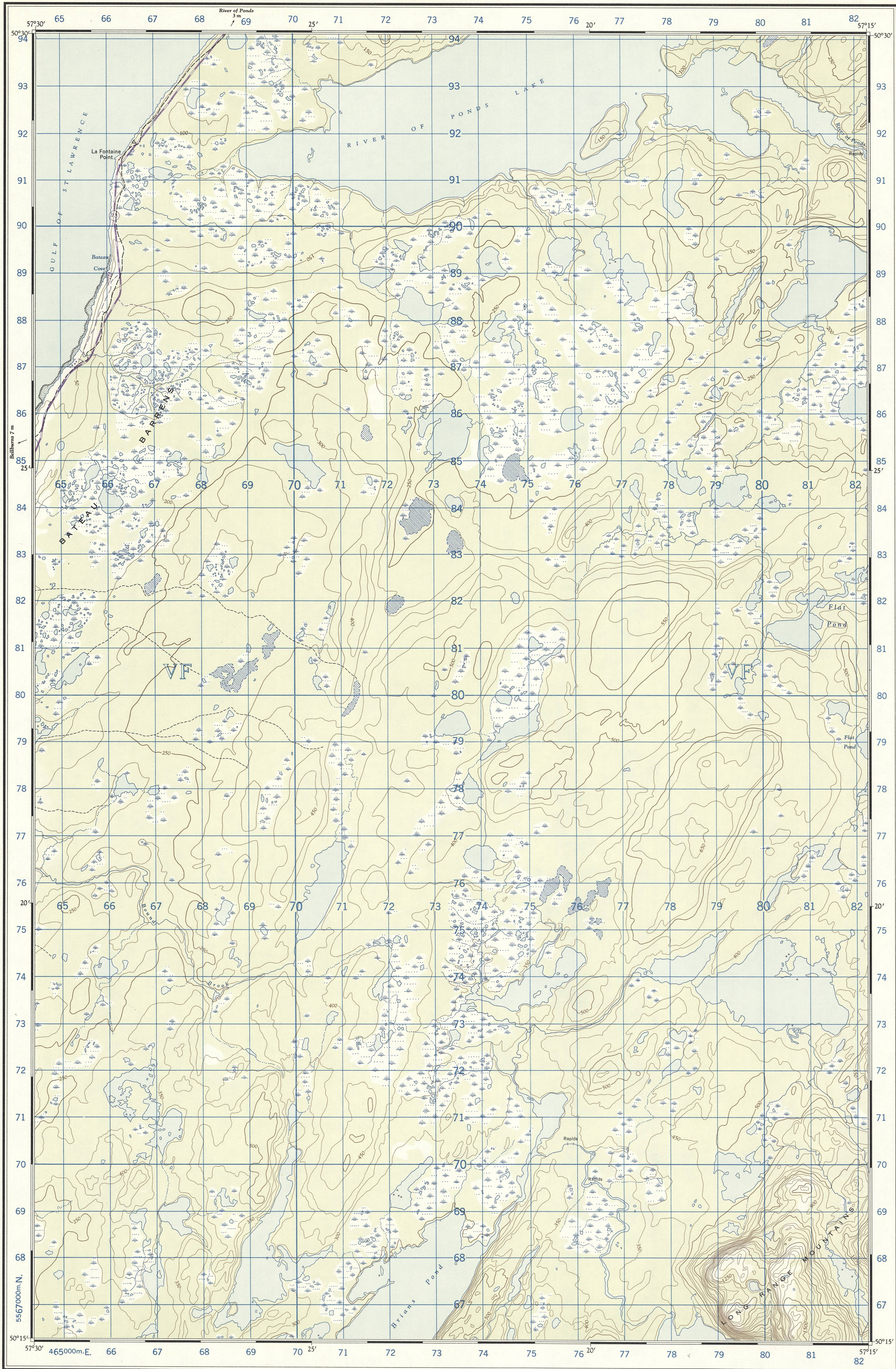
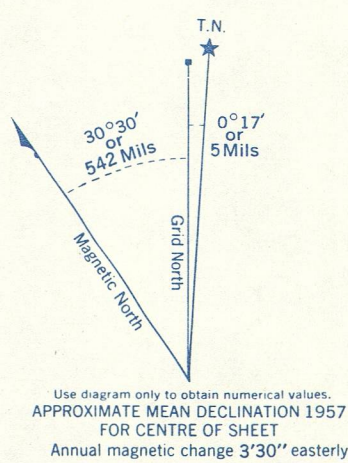

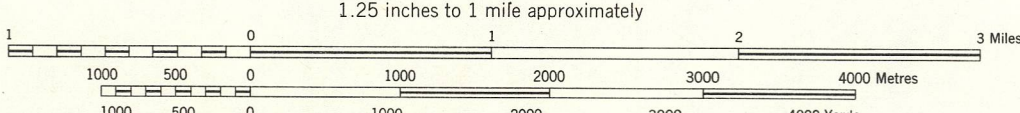

MAGNETIC DECLINATION 30°47' WEST AT CENTRE OF MAP 1957 Annual magnetic change 3°30' easterly

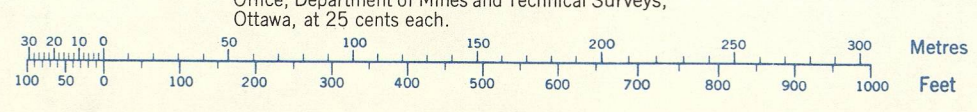
BLUE MOUNTAIN ST. BARBE DISTRICT NEWFOUNDLAND

GRID ZONE DESIGNATION	100,000 M. SQUARE IDENTIFICATION

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
EXAMPLE: STREAM JUNCTION

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.

NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.

Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
