

Resolutions of the Academy in Session. The Stagholders were called together in the chairless Academy of Music last evening for the purpose of discussing the financial situation.

Dr. Keator, President, related the efforts that had been made to get funds; blamed the students for the bad arrangement of the seats; and proposed that the Stagholders increase the stock enough to pay the Christmas claim, and the \$8,500 the Directors have advanced, or for the largest of them to give a bond to secure a sufficient loan against the liabilities.

The financial status of the Company was thus reported by the Secretary: The amount of stock subscribed and not paid in amounts to \$2,707, of which about \$1,000 may be considered collectible.

The disbursements since the last annual meeting have been as follows: On building, \$11,250. On furniture, \$1,125. On printing, \$1,125. On stationery, \$1,125. On interest, \$1,125. On miscellaneous, \$1,125.

The total amount paid out at different times for construction and maintenance, including \$8,500 advanced by the Directors, is \$38,400, and the total amount now due, exclusive of Directors' mortgage, is \$23,533.30, making the total cost and liability of the building and Company, to date, \$61,933.30.

After considerable talk, a motion made by Mr. McDevitt, that the stockholders be requested to subscribe one half more stock than they hold, was carried. After another long talk, it was moved by Mr. McDevitt, seconded by Mr. M. Driscoll, and carried, that the Directors be empowered to issue sufficient funds to pay the Christmas mortgage on the most advantageous terms possible.

So the future ownership of the Academy has not yet been decided. The vote of the stockholders may be empowered to funds to be obtained, and it may not.
