

The sum of \$160.00 was the amount of money our congregation was asked to contribute as our share the general schemes of the grand church in which we form a part. The total collected by the ladies and gentlemen appointed for the first year of our system is very satisfactory indeed, amounting to \$185.07, and has been distributed to the various schemes as follows:—

For the ensuing year \$168.00 is our share needed for the schemes.
