Emigration. The work inaugurated by the Canadian Emigration Society is being developed by this Society, and with the generous assistance of ministers of all denominations and other Christian friends both sides of the Atlantic (to whom references can be given), hundreds of deserving people who were having a hard time, are being transplanted to more favourable conditions in Canada. The Society constantly sends out young people connected with the various Protestant denominations, and respectfully solicits the co-operation of the ministers and Christian people of Canada so that these may be placed as nearly as possible along with those of their own denomination. A remittance of 25 cents, membership fee, to Kingsville, Ont. will secure full details, including information as to the terms upon which agents are appointed and remunerated.

Especially if their own Church will help the Society by accepting the services of British ministers also on tour, under its auspices.

Colonization. Friends of the Society are organizing Temperance Colonies and trying to build up towns and villages where the common enemy of our race—King Alcohol—is dethroned.

A training farm for British boys is being arranged in connection with the Mettawas property at Kingsville, on Pelee Island, and the Mettawas Hotel is being converted into a beautiful Hydropathic establishment and Summer hotel where British girls will be trained for domestic work.
