Real Character of Bolshevism

This article from the English. Statesman, is most illuminating:

It is important that we should, as far as possible understand what the real character and aims of Bolshevism are. We know in a general way that it is a reckless and cruel system, and that it has caused the direst tribulation and misery in the greater part of Russia. Bolshevism is the antithesis of genuine democracy. It does not desire free government of the people by the people and for the people. Its avowed object is the tyranny of those who have nothing over all who possess property of any kind. It does not regard the holders of political opinions differing from itself as loyal citizens of the same commonwealth but as enemies and traitors to be ruthlessly suppressed. It is frankly atheistical and antagonistic to all religion. Faith in God, it says, is faith in a universal state of slavery. True, it affirms that God does not exist, and that the supposed state of slavery is consequently a vain notion, but it declares that notion to be the cause of the world's troubles and eat hindrance to the spread of Bolshevist theories and methods.

Things might be very different if the Gospel had been faithfully proclaimed and the Bible freely circulated, and if masses and ikons had no place in Russia in the days gone by.
