An Act to consolidate the Laws relating to Public Lands, and to make better provision for the disposal and management of Public Lands.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

THE LAND DEPARTMENT --- THE COMMISSIONER --- THE OFFICERS.

I. All the Lands belonging to the Province, shall be under To what lands 5 the management and administration of the Public Department, the Act apwhich is and shall be denominated, the Land Department.

II. The Chief Officer of this Department shall be called the Commissioner Commissioner of Public Lands, and his duty shall be, under and his functhe directions of the Governor in Council, to superintend, exe-

- 10 cute and perform all such acts touching or respecting the Public Lands of the Province, as have heretofore been or hereafter shall be directed by law to be done; And from and after the passing of this Act, the executive duties now prescribed or which may hereafter be prescribed by
- 15 law, appertaining to the surveying and sale of the Public Lands in the Province, or in any wise respecting such Public Lands, and the issuing of Patents for all grants of land under the authority of the Government, shall be subject to the supervision and control of the Commissioner of Public Lands, under the 20 direction of the Governor in Council.

III. There shall be in the said Department an Officer to be Assistant appointed by the Governor in Council, and to be called the Commissioner Assistant Commissioner of Public Lands, to be employed and his func-therein as the Commissioner shall deem proper. 25 Commissioner shall, before he enters on the duties of his charge and appointment, take an oath or affirmation, truly and faithfully to execute the trust committed to him.

The Assistant Commissioner shall be the receiver of all To receive all moneys paid for and on account of sales of Public Lands, and moneys: to 30 shall be bound to give security for such sum and in such manner give security. as shall be prescribed by the Governor in Council, for the due performance of his duties.
