WALDEMAR WON'T ACCEPT

THE DANISH PRINCE REFUSES THE
BULGARIAN THRONE.

The Car in Favor of Prince Nicholas
of Greece Heard From About
the Russian Consulate.

TRONVA, Nov. 11.—Prince Waldemar has sent a telegram to the Danes expressing his grateful sense of the honor conferred upon him by the Danes in electing him Prince of Bulgaria. He states, however, that the decision to his acceptance rests with his father, the King of Denmark, and adds that other duties may prevent his assuming the rulership of Bulgaria. The Prince's reply is considered to be a refusal to accept the Bulgarian throne. The Bulgarian deputation appointed to convey to Prince Waldemar the official notice of his election by the Danes, to Prince Nicholas of Greece heard from about the Russian consulate in Copenhagen, where the Prince is sojourning.

ST. LOUIS, Nov. 11.—The evidence in the Princess of Wales case, as made public today, shows that the messenger, David S. Forthright, was an accessory, or at least a willing victim in the affair. Discrepancies in his statements to the detectives indicate that the robbery was planned and executed that he would like to have them know, and an expert opinion, given by the Grand Jury last Saturday, states that the three letters signed "Jim Cummings" were written by one of the robbers. It is also stated that the messenger's trunk was searched soon after the robbery, and a number of papers were found covered with copies of the signature of W. J. Barrett, manager of the Express Company. It is supposed the messenger became aware of this signature so that he might give it to the order with the robbery presented, which allowed him to enter the car. Altogether it looks bad for the messenger.

OSODA'S REIGNING RENAISSANCE.

Another Remarkable Hoisting of Women
at the Fair.

OSODA, Mich., Nov. 11.—In response to the meeting of the women of Osoda and Auvergne to express their indignation at the murder of Mabel Clark, and at the failure of the authorities to arrest Dr. David H. Weir, who repeatedly assailed her, a coroner's inquest was held today.
