

Fort George 19th May 1806.

Sir

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I received your letter of the 17th Inst this morning with its several enclosures.

HA During Mr Russell's administration, all requisitions were approved by him, but no prices carried out, that is done by the Secretary of Indian Affairs at Montreal, and I think he returns them to the Lieutenant Governor's Office for his authority for the issue. Therefore if you will return the enclosed, with the honorable Mr President Grant's approval, I will transmit them to the Secretary of Indian Affairs, who no doubt will do what has been customary.

The requisitions on the General Store at Lachine for the Messipaya purchase is to be approved by the President, and sent down to the Secretary of Indian Affairs, and the necessary authority in Original and Duplicate for the Store keeper General to issue the same, will accompany them.
