	10-10-42		<p>At 0800 hours ceiling and visibility unlimited, wind Southwest, very light, changing in the afternoon to south, 10 miles per hour. 10 hours solo, washed in at 0800 hours and washed out at 1800 hours. Night flying 2000 hours to 0200 hours. Ground fog coming in. Total flying time 298.25 hours.</p>	
	11-10-42		<p>At 1330 hours ceiling and visibility unlimited, wind N.N.W., 10 miles per hour. 4½ hours solo, Flying washed in at 1330 hours and washed out at 1600 hours. 2000 hours clear, very little wind, heavy ground fog by 2200 hours, washed out at 2200 hours. Total flying time 183.10 hours.</p>
