I have the honor of transmitting the proceedings with the Grand River Indian, at a Council held at Amnasho on the 27th November and finished at a second Council held at Hamilton, at the Head of Lake Ontario, on the 1st Instant.

You will perceive that I produced to the Chiefs, the Memorial, which in obedience to the directions of Mr John Sherbrooke while Governor of the Province, had been transmitted to me, I was in hopes anxious expectation that the same would have ordered an investigation into the charges brought against me in that vile and uncorroborated statement, which the proceedings will show you, they acknowledge to have seen, but not to the extent of accusation which the Instrument speaks, that their reception was,
