Memorandum for Mr. Baldwin.

The National Committee for the celebration of the Diamond Jubilee decided to erect tablets at Kingston and Adolphus town to the memory of Sir John A. Macdonald. These tablets are now ready for unveiling. May I ask you to confer with the Prime Minister about the possibility of his presiding over both ceremonies? It would seem advisable to proceed to the unveiling within the next two weeks before the weather becomes too severe. The National Committee would accept whatever date the Prime Minister would like to set himself. This ceremony being a part of the celebration of the Diamond Jubilee, I think personally that it would be politically advisable for the Prime Minister, or at least for his representative, to participate in this ceremony.
