

Kuomintang in China and of military political work must be agreed on with Comrade Borodin.

In the event of differences of opinion arising on these questions they must be referred to Moscow for investigation. Borodin and the Far East Bureau must keep Moscow's representative in Peking informed of all their decisions and moves with regard to these questions.

(iii) Comrade Borodin's appointment as official Soviet representative in Canton is considered inadvisable. Borodin is to remain (in charge) of the work in the Province under Canton rules and an official representative to the Canton Government is to be appointed". Ends.
