
Ottawa 4th November 1902-

I beg to inform you that the sworn Returns of Timber taken last Season from the Whitefish Lake Indian Reserve by the Saginaw Lumber and Salt Company have been examined and found correct. It is observed however, that they do not bear the usual certificate showing that they were examined by you and found satisfactory.

The Company transferred their right title and interest in the ~~Whitfish~~ Whitefish Lake Limits under License No 68 to The Traders Bank of Canada, under date of 3rd September last, but the transfer fee of \$124.00 and surety bond have not yet been received and consequently no renewal of the License has been made.
