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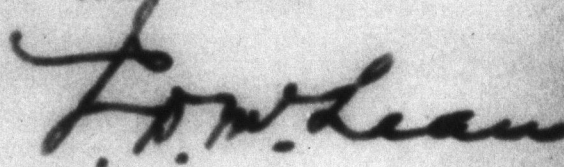
Ottawa, 20th July 1917.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 16th instant I have to inform you that our letter which you mention of the 14th July 1916 instructed you to call for tenders for two culverts, namely the Lacelle and Wampum culverts in the Moravian Indian reserve. Tenders were received for the construction of the Lacelle culvert only; consequently an Order in Council was obtained authorizing the expenditure from the funds of the band of the sum necessary for the construction of this one culvert, namely \$35.00 for the work and \$55.00 for the material.

You should obtain tenders from members of the band for the construction of the second culvert to which you refer. These should be addressed to you and opened at a meeting of the Council, who should then pass a resolution recommending the tender they desire to accept and requesting that the necessary sum be taken from their Capital funds.
