After I had explained Sect. 15 of the Indian Act, she then asked for a refund of the money she refused at the time of the distribution of the monies from the sale of the Iwachis Peserve No. 3, bf the Seashaht Fand in November 1913. When this money was paid the Seashaht Indians, I have a recollection that I explained this fully to her, but on this point I am not absolutely certain. However, if possible I would like that she get the amount that she refused at the time of the above mentioned payment, viz., nineteen dollars and twenty five cents.
