Sir,—

Mrs. Willian who was originally an Opitchesaht woman, but who married a Seashaht Indian, came to this office on the morning of the 29th. of Oct., and endeavored to establish her claim to the monies now coming to the Opitchesaht Band. After I had explained Sect. 15 of the Indian Act, she then asked for a refund of the money she refused at the time of the distribution of the monies from the sale of the Iwachis Reserve No. 3, of the Seashaht Band in November 1913. When this money was paid the Seashaht Indians, I have a recollection that I explained this fully to her, but on this point I am not absolutely certain.

However, if possible I would like that she get the amount that she refused at the time of the above mentioned payment, viz., nineteen dollars and twenty five cents.
