## MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER

Copies of Dominions Office telegram Circular D.206 on post-war civil aviation, together with copies of the attached draft interim reply have been sent to Mr. Howe and to Mr. Power, as the Ministers principally concerned, for their comments.

Mr. Howe approves the proposed reply. The United Kingdom message indicates that they have decided in principle to sponsor a policy of complete internationalization of civil aviation after the war. They do not anticipate that the full programme will prove acceptable to the United States, but are prepared to go just as far in this direction as the United States and other powers will go.

I assume that you will wish to have this matter discussed by the War Committee.
