

MR. EDEN: Fellow Delegates, Ladies and Gentlemen: The Fifth Plenary Session of the United Nations Conference on International Organization is hereby convened. For the convenience of my fellow delegates, I now announce that the Sixth Plenary Session will be held in this hall tomorrow, Tuesday afternoon, at 3:30 o'clock.

The first item on our agenda today is the Report of the Rapporteur of a meeting of the heads of delegations on the organization of the Conference.

I call upon the Chairman of the Delegation of Cuba, Rapporteur of the meeting of the heads of delegations.

MR. BELT: Mr. Chairman, Fellow Delegates: The chairmen of all delegations represented at the United Nations Conference on International Organization held their third meeting on April 30, 1945, at 11 a.m.; the Honorable Edward R. Stettinius, Jr., President of the Conference, acted as chairman.

Seating of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic and the Byelo-Russian Soviet Socialist Republic at the Conference:

The meeting recommends to the Conference in plenary session that the Conference, having decided that the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic and the Byelo-Russian Soviet Socialist Republic be invited to be initial members of the proposed International Organization, their representatives be permitted to take their seats at the Conference immediately, as they have requested through the representative of the Soviet Union.

MR. EDEN: Any observations on that resolution? (pause) No observations? The resolution is approved.

MR. BELT: Seating of the Argentine Republic at the Conference:

The meeting recommends to the Conference in plenary session that the representatives of the Argentine Republic should be permitted to take their seats at the Conference immediately.
