Indian Agent Harper Reed under date of November 28th notifies this office that the trapping ground registered in the name of Roy and Mike Pat McCluskey is not being trapped and as there is very little likelihood of these Indians trapping the ground that same should be cancelled.

Mr. Reed states that Mr. McCluskey and his boys wish to take over the ground registered in the name of Mike McCluskey on Moore Creek as this old Indian has now been placed on relief owing to sickness and general infirmities. I should like to be informed if this cancellation and change in registration are approved.

Mr. Reed's sketch is enclosed for your information and I should be glad to have this returned after you have made a comparison with your own records.
