

TITLE :

- with possession gives right to mortgage, 15.
- where it is agreed that title to property shall not pass till paid for, a mortgage from vendor will preceede sale to conditional vendee, 15.
- conferred by mortgagee selling under power of sale even without right to sell, 61.
- no warranty by mortgagee, 85.
- not acquired by parol without possession, 281.

TRADER :

- purchases from, in usual course, 400, 401.
- obtaining possession without ownership, 400.

TRANSFER :

- defined, 401.
- a mortgage is a transfer of the property as well as a security for the debt, 2.
- of right to, or title in property essential to a mortgage, 10.

TROVER : See ACTION.

TRUST :

- when omission of, an informality, 271.

TRUSTEE : See CREDITORS.

UNDUE INFLUENCE :

- a ground for admitting parol evidence, 5.

VENDEE :

- and vendor, in a conditional sale, have each a mortgagable interest, 15.
- a person may have mortgagable interest though no title may ever vest, 15.

VENDOR :

- and vendee, in a conditional sale, have each a mortgagable interest, 13.
