An Act to oblige thips and veffels coming from places infected with the plague or any peftilential fever or difease, to perform Quarentine, and prevent the communication thereof in this Province.

An Act for allowing Pot and Pearl afhes to lie brought into this Province by land or inland navigation, for prohibiting the importation of Tobacco from the United States, for regulating the fees of the Cuftom House Officer of St. John's and for repealing the Act or Ordinance therein mentionsd.

An Act to amend and make perpetual an Act passed in the twentieth year of his Majefty's reign, intituled, "An Ordinance for regulating all luch perform as keep Horfes and Carriages to let and hire for the accommodation of travellers commonly called by the name-of Maîtres de Poste.

An Act for granting to his Majelly Duties on Licences to hawkers, pedlars and petty chapmen, and for regulating their trade; and for granting additional Duties on licences to perfons for keeping houses of public entertainment, or for retailing wine, brandy, rum or other spirituous liquors in this Province, and for regulating the fame; and for repealing the Act or Ordinance therein mentioned.

An Act for granting to his Majefly an additional and new Ditties on certain goods, wares and merchandifes, and for appropriating the fame towards further defraying the charges of the administration of Justice, and support of the civil government within this Province, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

An Act to remove any doubts that may arife regarding the validity of certain proceedings in the Superior Terms of the Court of King's Bench at Montreal.

An Act for continuing certain parts of an Act paffed in the last Selfion of the Legislature, intituled "An

" Act for establishing regulations respecting Aliens and certain subjects of his Majetty, who have refided in

" France, coming into this Province or reliding therein; and for empowering his Majelly to fecure and

" detain perfous charged with or fulpected of High Treason, and for the ariest and commitment of all

" perfons who may, individually, by feditious practices, attempt to diffurb the Government of this " Province."

An Act to declare and alcertain the Period when the Acts of the Provincial Parliament of this Province that take effect.

An Act for indemnifying all Perfons who have been concerned in Advising and carrying into execution an Order or Proclamation of the Governor in Council of the Ninth day of September last, refrecting an Embargo on all Vessels laden or to be loden in whole or in part with Wheat, Peafe, Oats, Barley, Indian Corn, Flour and Bifcuit, for preventing fuits in confequence of the fame, and for making further provision relative thereto.

An Act for the Safe-Cnitody and Registering of all Letters Patent, whereby any Grant of the waste or other Lands of the Crown lying within this Province shall be reafter be made.

An Act for allowing the Importation of fresh or salted Beef and Pork and Hogslard, for a limited time, from the United States of America.

An Act for better regulating the Weight and Rates at which certain Coins shall pass Current in this Province, for preventing the fallifying, counterfeiting or impairing the same, and for repealing the Act or Ordinance therein mentioned.

An Act for appointing Commiffioners on behalf of this Province, to treat further with Commiffioners on behalf of the Province of Upper-Canada, for the purpoles therein mentioned.

An Act for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by Land or by Inland Navigation.

An Act for further continuing certain parts of an Act passed in thirty-fourth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for establishing regulations respecting Aliens and certain subjects of His Majesty, who "have resided in France, coming into this Province or residing therein, and for empowering His Ma214
