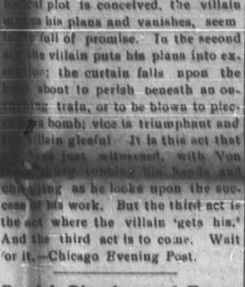
**Before the Boys Come Back.**

**Idleness in Canada is now a Crime.**  
PUNISHABLE BY FINE OR IMPRISONMENT—WE SHOULD WORRY.  
An order-in-Council to suppress idleness has been adopted by the government. It provides that every male person shall be regularly engaged in some useful occupation, with the exception of persons under sixteen years of age and over sixty, or physically unfit, or a student or temporarily unemployed. Violation of the provisions renders liability to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars or in default of payment with hard labor, not exceeding six months. The order becomes effective at once.

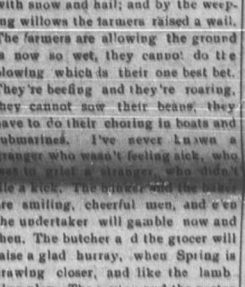
