 The retail price of all grades of War Standard Flour shall not exceed \$13.25 per barrel within the Municipal limits of the town of St. John's, and in the outports \$15.25 with the addition of an amount equivalent to insurance while in transit and freight actually paid thereon from St. John's to the point of sale, and shall not exceed \$1.20 per stone within the Municipal limits of St. John's, and in the outports \$1.50, plus an amount equivalent to insurance while in transit and freight actually paid thereon from St. John's to the point of sale. dec10,21
