Toronto Produce Market.

Toronto, Aug. 11.—Wheat—Quiet; old red and white, 68c bid and 70c asked; new is 67c west; Manitoba steady; No. 1 hard is quoted at 90c; grinding in transit; 83c at Port William, 82c at Toronto and west, and 85c at Midland. Flour—Steady; cars of 90 per cent patents are quoted at \$2.70 to \$2.75 in buyers' bags west; Manitoba flour is steady, at \$4.50 to \$4.60 for cars of patents, and \$4.25 for strong bakers here. Millfeed—Steady; cars of shorts are quoted at \$14.50 to \$15, and bran at \$11 to \$11.50. Barley—Steady; new No. 2 extra is quoted at 24c, and No. 2 at 23c west. Rye—Steady; new is quoted at 30c east and 28c west. Corn—Firm; Canada yellow is quoted at 40c west; new American is steady, at 47c west. Oats—Steady, at 20c for old white west; new, 25c west. Oatmeal is quoted at \$3.10 for cars of bags, and \$3.20 for barrels here; small quantities, 2c more. Peas—Unsettled and nominal, at 60c west. Butter—Dairy pound rolls would bring 19c to 20c here; good to choice dairy tubs, 16c to 17c, and common at 14c to 15c; creamery tubs, at 20c to 21c for prints, and 19c to 20c for packages. Eggs—Supply fair; steady, at 12c to 12 1/2c.

American Market.

NEW YORK, Aug. 11.—Flour—Receipts, 19,631 barrels; sales, 2,300 packages; estate and western weak and unsettled, being 3c to 10c lower to sell. Rye flour quiet. Wheat—Receipts, 44,499 bushels; sales, 1,850,000 bushels; options weak and considerably lower this morning, drop in corn liquidation and lower cables; Sept., 80 1/2-16c to 80 1/2-16c. Rye flour, Corn—Receipts, 161,023 bushels; sales, 170,000 bushels; options weak and much lower through heavy unloading, inspired by rains in the southwest; September, 43 1/2c to 44c; December, 40 1/2c to 41c; May, 41 1/2c to 42c. Oats—Receipts, 60,500 bushels; options dull and weaker; track, white state and white western, 28c to 30c. Butter—Receipts, 3,047 packages; firm; state dairy, 16c to 19c; creamery, 17c to 20c; current packed, factory, 14c to 15c. Cheese—Receipts, 1,864 packages; firm; large colored, 10c; small colored, 10 1/2c; large white, 10c; small white, 10 1/2c. Eggs—Receipts, 4,382 packages; quiet. Sugar—Raw firm; centrifugal, 9c test, 4 1/2c to 4 5/8c; centrifugal, 9c test, 4 1/2c. Molasses sugar, 4c to 4 1/2c; refined firm. Coffee quiet; No. 7, Rio, 9 1/2c. Lead dull. Wool dull. Hops quiet.
