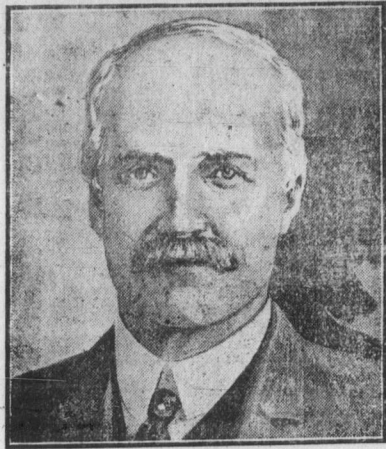

The emergency brakes were put on but the engine struck the car, lifting it and the van clear of the track. The car mounted the engine. Both crews stuck to their posts and fortunately escaped injury. A breakman was on the box car with a lantern, but he escaped in a most marvellous manner. Con. Dickie was in the van getting up his way bills when the crash came. He had to crawl out a window.

Council Decides to Raise \$12,000
to Meet Departmental Expenses

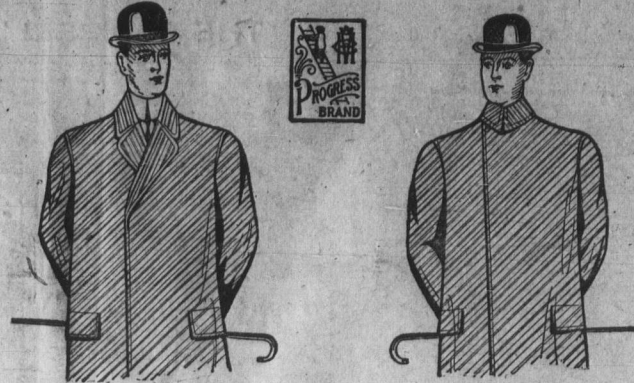
CANADA'S NET DEBT

IS \$336,268,546

Ottawa, Nov. 10.—According to the public accounts volume published today the funded debt of Canada payable in London was 52,900,902 pounds at the end of the last fiscal year. The net debt of the Dominion was \$336,268,546, an increase of \$12,338,267. Accounts show consolidated fund receipts of \$101,503,710; expenditure \$79,411,574, leaving a surplus on this account of \$22,091,963. In addition to this, however, there was a total capital or special expenditure of \$35,971,911, of which \$19,968,064 was on the National Transcontinental Railway, and \$2,414,171 on bounties.

WOMEN LEFT EMPTY FLASKS

Toronto, Nov. 11.—Dr. Orr, manager of the Canadian National exhibition in reply to the W. C. T. U., which complained of the amount of drunkenness at the exhibition, makes the unexpected statement that there were as many empty flasks found in the women's building as in the quarters for the men.
