Scientific and Useful.

DELICATE CAKE.—One pound of sugar three-quarters of a pound of butter, one pound of flour, and the whites of eighteen eggs.

The short double-breasted Coats so much worn this season are being made in large numbers by Peiley & Peiley from the materials imported especially by them of this style of garment.

LEMON CREAM PIE.—One cup of sugar, one tablespoonful of butter, one egg, one lemon prepared carefully, one teaspoonful of corn starch wet in cold water, one cup of boiling water.

FRUIT CAKE.—One pound of sugar, three-quarters of a pound of butter, ten eggs, one pound of flour, four pounds of raisins, two and a half pounds of currants, one and a half pounds of citron, nutmeg, ground mace, essence of lemon, and a gill of brandy.

DELICATE CAKE, NO. 2.—One pound of sugar, three-quarters of a pound of flour, one half pound of butter, the whites of fourteen eggs. Let the butter get a little warm, then beat it until it is like cream.

CRANBERRY PUDDING.—Cranberry pudding is made by pouring boiling water on a pint of dried bread crumbs; melt a tablespoonful of butter and stir in.

FRENCH CRUST FOR RAISED PIES.—To every pound of flour allow half a teaspoonful of salt, two eggs, third of a pint of water, six ounces of butter.
