tion is complete, the yellow spots with which the dressing has been marked become red. The colouring matter consists of one hundred and fifty parts of a solution of aluminum accetate, one hundred and fifty parts of water, and five parts of a twenty-one per cent. alizarine paste.—The Physician and Surgeon.
