**T**HERE are six handsome color inserts in the September number of the *International Studio*. This fine art publication is a delight to the eye from cover to cover. It contains many illustrations, reproducing paintings, sculpture, and other works of art. Beginning this month the *North American Review* is being published fortnightly instead of monthly as heretofore.

The *Four Track News* has been sold by George H. Danck to a company, headed by Walter A. Johnson. The name will be changed to the *Travel Magazine* and the pages will be enlarged considerably.
