

Mr. Bird is still at New York, and intends publishing another work on chess. We understand that he has had many promises of support in his undertaking, both here and in the United States.

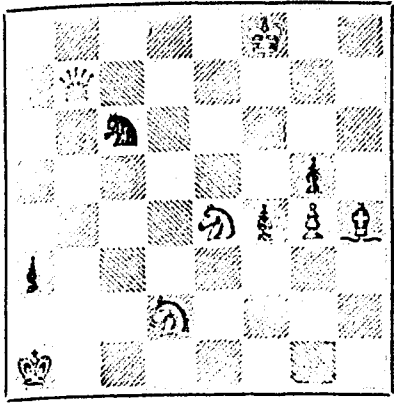

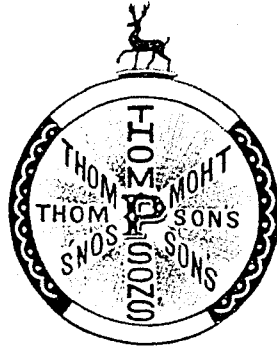
