Besides these there are: One BRISLEY Exhibition (\$50); Three STEVENSON Science Scholarships (\$80); One MCCAWLEY Hebrew Prize (\$38); One COGSWELL Scholarship (\$120), open for Candidates for Holy Orders; One MCCAWLEY Testimonial Scholarship (\$33); One AKINS Historical Prize (\$30); One ALMON-WEISFORD Testimonial (\$24); One HALIBURTON Prize (\$20); One COGSWELL Cricket prize. The necessary expenses of Board, Rooms, &c., average \$155 per annum. Nominated students do not pay tuition fees.
