No. 11

1. An airline designated by the Government of Sweden may operate a service originating in Sweden and terminating in or passing through Canada on the route specified below, and may take on and put down at Montreal passengers, mail and cargo for and from Sweden.

2. The route to be operated by the designated airline of the Government of Sweden shall be:—

AGREEMENT

Stockholm via intermediate points to Montreal and to points in territories beyond in both directions

3. An airline designated by the Government of Canada may operate a service originating in Canada and terminating in or passing through Sweden on the route specified below and may take on and put down at Stockholm passengers, mail and cargo for and from Canada.

CANADA

4. The route to be operated by the designated airline of the Government of Canada shall be:—

THE UNITED KINGDOM

Montreal via intermediate points to Stockholm and to points in territories beyond in both directions

SUMMARY

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7. Tariffs to be charged by the airlines shall, in the first instance, be between them. Any tariffs so agreed shall be subject to the approval of the competent aeronautical authorities of the contracting parties, and, in the event of disagreement, settlement shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Article 9 of this Agreement.



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
