in South Africa with particular concern. We agreed that a peaceful and lasting solution can only be found to crisis if the apartheid regime is present the dismantled and replaced by a new form of democratic. need. government. an urgent There is non-racial dialogue with genuine the begin a therefore. to representatives of all the components of South African society. At the same time we noted the importance of humanitarian assistance initiatives for the victims of Apartheid and of supporting the efforts by SADCC (Southern African Development Coordination Conference) member states to develop and strengthen their own economies.

Serious concern was expressed at the continuing dangerous tensions and conflicts in the Near and Middle East and at the absence of concrete progress toward a solution to the Arab-Israeli dispute. The need for action to create conditions for a just, global and lasting peace was reaffirmed.

Preoccupation was also expressed about the situation in the occupied territories.

serious Lebanon. with its internal persisting problem of 'the the antagonisms and give camps. continues to cause for Palestinian apprehension. In this connection we reaffirmed our hope national made towards that genuine efforts be reconciliation. 4.1

With regard to Latin America, the discussion highlighted the need to promote appropriate initiatives supporting democratic governments and aimed at democracy and 🐳 its encouraging the return to consolidation throughout the continent. There was also agreement that efforts toward regional integration will help open up a fruitful and constructive dialogue with the West: they therefore deserve support.

With regard to developments in Central America, it is hoped that the forthcoming Summit to be held in Guatemala can play a positive role in paving the way to peace and stability.

Finally, we turned to the problems of the United Nations Organizations and, in particular to its current financial difficulties and considered possible ways of overcoming them.
