PAKISTAN

Due to local dietary habits, seafood is limited to coastal areas and only fresh seafood is consumed. The Pakistan domestic seafood catch is obtained from the Arabian Sea near Karachi, most of it is consumed locally and the balance is processed almost entirely for export. The local Pakistan market price of seafood is relatively low. However, imports of frozen fish and processed seafood are subject to high tariffs (80% import duty and a 15% sales tax).
