

12:30 p.m. The Governor General and Mme Vanier, the Prime Minister and Mrs. Pearson, the Lieutenant-Governor and Mrs. MacDonald, and the Premier and Mrs. Shaw will arrive for luncheon aboard the Yacht. (No press coverage at any time during the visit aboard the Yacht, but shots of arrivals and departures may be obtained.)

2:15 p.m. The Royal Couple disembark and the Prime Minister presents the Secretary of State and Mme Lamontagne.

The arrival ceremonies include a Royal Salute and 21-Gun Salute, and the inspection of the Guard of Honour.

(Normal press coverage with assigned positions as indicated in previous briefings.)

2:30 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh leave by slow drive through various parts of the city for the Fathers of Confederation Memorial Buildings. Since these buildings are only about three blocks up Queen Street from the D.O.T. dock, the press can easily walk before the arrival of the Royal Couple or can board buses to follow the cavalcade.

2:45 p.m. The Royal Couple arrive at the front terrace of the Memorial Buildings and are escorted by Premier and Mrs. Shaw to the dais.

(Normal press coverage with fixed positions.)

2:50 p.m. Five minute speeches by the Premier and Prime Minister commemorating the 1864 Conference, followed by a five-minute speech by Her Majesty. Presentation of the Mayor and the Provincial Cabinet will then take place.

(Normal press coverage with fixed positions.)
