

**- FEDERAL PARTY STANDINGS -
- THE LIBERALS' "RED BOOK" PROMISES -
- THE PUBLIC AGENDA -**

The latest National Angus Reid/Southam News Poll, conducted between May 28th and June 2nd among a representative cross-section of 1,516 Canadians, gauged the federal party standings, asked voters to assess the job the federal Liberal government has done on delivering its "Red Book" promises, and took an inventory of the public's policy issues agenda.

Overall, the Chretien Liberals continue to ride high in popular support, while there has been some interesting movement among the Reform and Conservative parties this past month. These poll results also find that the public gives the federal Liberals fairly poor marks for their delivery on their "Red Book" election promises, but this evidently has not hurt their support levels and, indeed, even most voters who are skeptical about how much of their platform the Liberals will deliver on during this mandate say this will have no impact on the likelihood of their voting Liberal in the next election.
