

(c) for any control period commencing no later than the calendar year 1998, no more than 15 percent of the quantity calculated pursuant to paragraph (a)2

(3) For the purpose of subsection (2), the number of tonnes of each chlorofluorocarbon imported into Canada in the calendar year 1986 by a person described in subsection (2) shall not exceed the number of tonnes reported by that person to Environment Canada in response to the notice entitled Environmental

2. As a first step, Canada will publish in the Canada Gazette, Part I, a proposed regulation to reduce annual production and consumption of CFCs to 50% of the 1986 level by 1998 to ensure compliance with the Montreal Protocol. Contaminants Act Survey of Producers, Importers and Exporters, and Users of Chlorofluorocarbons and Bromofluorocarbons, published in the Canada Gazette, Part I, December 19, 1987 and the Environmental Contaminants Act Notice with respect to Chlorofluorocarbons and Bromofluorocarbons.

(4) The Minister may

(a) increase the import reference weighted aggregate quantity for the import of chlorofluorocarbon by a person described in subsection (1) during a control period by an amount specified in subsection (5), or

(b) assign to any other person an import reference weighted aggregate quantity for the import of chlorofluorocarbon during a control period in an amount specified in subsection (5)

where

(c) a person described in subsection 4(1) has agreed in writing to have his manufacture reference weighted aggregate quantity for the manufacture of chlorofluorocarbon reduced for that control period by that amount and the Government of Canada has agreed with the government of another Party to the Protocol to transfer a like amount of its calculated level of production of chlorofluorocarbon to that other Party, for the purpose of industrial rationalization; or

(d) a person described in subsection (1) has agreed in writing to have his import reference weighted aggregate quantity for the import of chlorofluorocarbon reduced for that control period by that amount.

(5) For the purposes of subsection (4), the amount specified is an amount that does not exceed
