

## Questions

3. Are any other prosecutions, similar to those referred to above, contemplated by the corporation? If so, in how many cases?

Mr. ILSLEY:

1 and 2. An information was laid by Royal Canadian Mounted Police, against Samuel Gross and Reuben Gross, reading as follows: ". . . that Reuben Gross and Samuel Gross in the months of April and May in the year 1944 at the city of Toronto, in the county of York, unlawfully did corruptly give or agree to give or offer a gift or consideration to C. C. Cardoza, a person employed by the commodity prices stabilization corporation as an inducement or reward or consideration to the said C. C. Cardoza for doing or forbearing to do, or having done or forborne to do an act relating to the affairs or business of the commodity prices stabilization corporation or for showing favour or forbearing to show disfavour to the National Rubber Company Limited with relation to the affairs or business of the commodity prices stabilization corporation contrary to the criminal code, section 504 in such case made and provided."

An information was laid by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, against Maurice Levine, reading as follows: ". . . that Maurice A. Levine in the months of April and May in the year 1944 at the city of Toronto, in the county of York, unlawfully did corruptly give or agree to give or offer a gift or consideration to C. C. Cardoza, a person employed by the commodity prices stabilization corporation, as an inducement or reward or consideration to the said C. C. Cardoza for doing or forbearing to do or having done or forborne to do an act relating to the affairs or business of the commodity prices stabilization corporation, or for showing favour for forbearing to show disfavour in the Inner Spring Mattress and Cushion Company Limited with relation to the affairs or business of the commodity prices stabilization corporation contrary to the Criminal Code, section 504 in such case made and provided."
