A. (i) That graduates of the following Chinese Universities in technical subjects should be, for the present, admitted to graduate work with the understanding that they may be required to carry out certain undergraduate work if desirable.

(ii) That students of the universities mentioned in paragraph A (1), or of the following colleges who are in possession of certificates stating that they have successfully completed at least two years of study and are well qualified in English, should be for the present admitted to undergraduate standing in Arts or Engineering, without further examination, on the basis that the first year will be one of probation under special advisors and a student's standing only settled at the end of such year except in caxes where standing can be determined at entrance. While it is impossible to establish a general equivalence, a student who has successfully completed two years and is qualified in English should it is hoped, generally speaking, be qualified to enter the second year of an Arts course or the first year of an Engineering course.
