was the first Time the French had an uncontested Right to Nova Scotia, so this was the Time when the just Limits were first authoritatively settled by themselves. These then must be esteemed by them to be the ancient Limits, and these are the ancientLimits ascribed it at present by the English.

The State of Nova Scotia, or Acadie, being brought into fo good a Regulation, every Thing remained quiet for a confiderable Time, each of the Proprietors being industrious to make the best of his own Peculiar, and all growing rich upon the Profits of the Fish and Furr Trades.

But in the Year 1647 the Governors began to quarrel with each other, and fell into civil Broils and Diffentions among themfelves, which paved the Way not only for their own Ruin, but alfo brought on the Lofs of the whole Province to their Mother Kingdom.

One of these Governors called *Charnifé*, who fucceeded *Razilli*, growing richer and more powerful than the reft, and having by the original Conftitution fome Superintendancy likewise over the whole, formed a Defign of driving the other two out of their Demesses, and of monopolizing the whole Trade to himself.

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
