filled this fudden venom into their fouls? It is indeed little to be wondered at, that a people treated like brutes for fo many centuries, fhould become like brutes when they broke their chain.

It may, perhaps, be fafer in this Chriftian land, for the man who rejoiced that there were prifons for the libellers of a Queen, to libel a whole nation, and to advife the cutting of his fellow creatures throats from generation to generation, than it is for another to inculcate charity to our neighbours, by a candid flatement of facts, and demonstrable truth. But as my tour induced me to relate the things I faw, and as thefe things led me naturally to the reflections that accompany the mention of them, I defy reproach, and truft that my readers will show fome indulgence to the hafty production of an unskilful pen-
