IN THE

CHURCH OF THE URSULINES

These Paintings were purchased chiefly in France, in the early part of the present century, by Rev. Louis Desjardins, Vicar-General of the Archbishop of Paris.

The Ursulines came to Quebec in 1639 ; this Church, (their second) was built in 1724.
