

Mining Market Reflects Incoming of Public Interest

WHEAT MARKET SAGS IN WEEK-END SESSION

Domestic Developments Failed to Provide Any Inspiration for Bull Coterie—War News Was More Favorable—Corn and Oats Easier.

CHICAGO, Oct. 19.—Hedging sales from the northwest had a depressing effect today on wheat. The market closed easy, 1-4c to 3-8c under last night. Corn showed a net loss of 1-8c to 1-4c, oats finished unchanged to 1-4c down, and provisions varying from 1-12c decline to an advance of 7-12c.

Northwestern pressure on the selling side of wheat resulted from the fact that the week's terminal receipts were double those of a year ago. There was apparently no hedging by Chicago houses. Bullish sentiment here, however, had become dwindle by the time bids for export business and by weakness at Winnipeg, where foreign activity develops first.

Russian official estimates of a greatly enlarged winter crop counted also in favor of the bears. About the only opposing influence came from week-end evening up, few traders caring to stand out over Sunday with a large open interest.

Better weather and scant demand tended to weaken corn. Oats suffered neglect, but held relatively steady. Covering by shorts made provisions for the most part firm. The only important exception was October pork.
