TO PROSECUTE FISHERMEN DESPITE MODUS VIVENDI

Newfoundland Government Announces a Policy That May Stir Up Considerable Trouble.

St. John's, Nfld., Nov. 1.—The colonial government has decided to test the validity of the modus vivendi. It has issued an official notice to-day enforcing the Bait Act, which forbids Newfoundlanders to fish on board foreign vessels within colonial waters, and it intends to prosecute one or more colonial fishermen who have been shipped by Americans outside the three-mile limit, after these men have been paid off by American vessels on which they were serving.

THE DIFFICULTY EXPLAINED.

Hon. A. B. Morine, now of Toronto, but formerly leader of the opposition in the parliament of Newfoundland, and ex-minister of fisheries for the island colony, has explained to the Empire Club luncheon yesterday. He explained at some length the recent disturbance in Newfoundland respecting the fisheries and contended that the imperial government had shown to the colony every consideration.
