The statement that the Canadian Corps is the best fighting corps on the western front has never been contradicted, according to Capt. Archibald, a well-known Canadian athlete, who has ceturned after over two years at the front, who addressed a mass meeting at the Y. M. C. A. Auditorium Sunday afternoon.
