MINING STOCKS QUIET BUT FIRM

Lull is Expected to Be of Brief Duration—Trethewey Sells Higher.

Mining stocks moved within a rather narrow range on Saturday, and many closed exactly on a parity with the final quotations of Friday. The tone was quietly firm, with holders of stocks betraying little or no inclination to make concessions.

Kirkland Lake was given good support on Saturday, the big producers, such as Hollinger, Dome and McIntyre, are preparing for a big speeding-up program, and the balmy spring breeze has been blowing from the market well under way, so say the wisecracks.
