12.—Patients may be visited by their friends on Thursdays, between he hours of 2 and 5 p.m., and on any evening, Sundays excepted, from 7 to 8 p. m.

13.—Any patient bringing liquor into the Home, or found intoxicated will be discharged.

14.—At nine o'clock lights must be out and perfect quiet must be observed in the wards.

15.—Whenever patients misbehave or violate any of the Rules of the Home, the Matron may at once discharge them.

16.—No chewing of tobacco allowed in the building or on the verandah; nor smoking except in the place allotted to that purpose in the basement.

17.—The Committee of Management will not allow any nails to be put into either walls or woodwork in any part of the house. No pictures or mottos are to be hung or pasted on the walls in any part of the house, and patients who in any way disfigure any part of the Home will be subject to dismissal.
