The Clerks are directed to have 700 copies of the Minutes of this Yearly Meeting, both Men's and Women's printed, and to contain copies of Epistles received from other Yearly Meetings, and Calendars of the times for holding our Meetings, and of the Yearly Meetings with which we correspond, also the names of the respective correspondents of said meetings; to apportion and forward the said copies to the persons appointed to receive them, and to draw upon the Treasurer for the funds necessary to meet the expense.

The Representatives report that they have examined the Treasurer's accounts and find them correct, with a balance on hand of \$339.65.

They recommend that the sum of \$100.00 be raised for the use of the Yearly Meeting for the current year, which is satisfactory to the meeting, and the Quarterly Meetings are directed to raise their proportion of the same, and to forward the balances due on former quotas, which, if paid, would relieve this meeting from its liabilities.
