The different payments must be invariably made in two instalments and strictly in advance. The first payment must be made at the opening of the classes and the second at the beginning of February.

Classical books are furnished by the institution at parents' expenses.

All sick scholars are intrusted to the care of the Sisters of the Holy Cross Hospital, and the bill is charged to their parents account.

Interest will be exacted for all arrears.

No deduction will be made for an absence of less than thirty consecutive days for boarders, and two consecutive months for outside boarders.

Every student must habitually wear the uniform of the house, which consists of a black frock-coat with white seams, a blue sash and a military black cap.

Every student must be provided with a suit of altar clothes which is composed of a black cassock and a surplice.

Every new student must present on his arrival a certificate of good behaviour from his parish priest, or if he has been in an other institution from the president thereof.

During the academical year, which lasts ten months about, parents will receive thrice, a report of their children's progress and deportment.
