this Grand Lodge do instruct its G. Representative to the next annual Communication of the Supreme Grand Lodge, to support the Report of a Committee of that Grand body, recorded in its last Annual Journal of Proceedings, page 2458, in so far as the last clause thereof is concerned, should the subject again come up for consideration.

On motion of Rep. Henry, seconded by Rep. Bissell a vote of thanks was awarded to the Committee on Constitution and By-Laws, &c., for the government of this Grand Lodge and its subordinates, for the able manner in which they have performed the important duty assigned to them.

On motion of Rep. VanBrocklin, seconded by Rep. Merrill, that it be Resolved,—That when this Grand Lodge adjourns, it do stand adjourned to meet at the Town of Brantford, on the first Wednesday in August, 1857.

It was moved in amendment by Rep. Laing, seconded by Rep. Henry, that this Grand Lodge do hold its next Session at the City of London.

The amendment being put and carried, the original motion was lost.

On motion of Rep. VanBrocklin, seconded by Rep. Yale, it was ordered that the Constitution, By-Laws, and Rules of Order for the government of the Grand Lodge and its Subordinates, finally adopted at the present Session, shall go into effect immediately from and after the publication thereof.

On motion of Rep. VanBrocklin, seconded by Rep. Yale, the Grand Secretary was instructed to have the Journal of Proceedings of this Grand body, from the time of its institution down to the present Session inclusive, printed in pamphlet form; and that 200 copies be obtained for the use of this Grand Lodge and its Subordinates.
